Article IV: Officers and Their Elections

Section I: Officers:

- A. The officers of this PTO shall be President, Vice-President, Treasurer, Recording Secretary, and Corresponding Secretary. Officer positions may be shared.
- B. The Principal shall be the PTO Advisor.
- C. The PTO President of the previous year shall be the advisor of the PTO President of the current year.
- D. The Officers of this PTO, the Principal Advisor, the President's Advisor, and a minimum of two or maximum of three Teacher representatives chosen by the Teachers of Beaver Creek Elementary School shall constitute the Executive Board. The Principal Advisor shall be a non-voting member.
- E. Officers shall assume their official duties on July 1st and server for a term of one (1) year.
- F. To be eligible for nomination as an officer, a member must meet one of the following qualifications:
 - a. Have attended a minimum of one regularly scheduled PTO meetings from September through March of the current school year.
 - b. Have volunteered a minimum of five (5) hours on projects or programs directly related to the PTO during the current school year.
 - c. Have served as chair or co-chair of one PTO committee during the current school year.
- G. An officer shall not be eligible to serve more than two (2) consecutive terms in the same office.
- H. An officer can be removed from office for failure to fulfill his/her duties, after reasonable notice, by a majority vote of the Executive Board.

Section II. The Election of Officers:

- A. There shall be a Nominating Committee, consisting of a chairperson and at least two (2) general members selected by the Executive Board in March.
- B. Nominations shall be made by any of the following:
 - a. Any eligible member may nominate him/herself.
 - b. Any eligible member may be nominated by another member with their consent.
 - c. Any eligible members may be solicited by the Nominating Committee, with their consent.
 - d. Eligibility will be confirmed by the Nominating Committee.
 - e. Nominees may not be a Nominating Committee member.
 - f. If by the April meeting there is not at least one eligible nominee for each board position, the Nominating Committee may submit to the current board one or more names for consideration of members who do not meet at least one criteria in Article IV, Section 1f. The current board may approve by majority vote one or more of the candidates submitted in this manner by the Nominating Committee to be eligible to stand for election on the completed slate. This applies only to positions for which there is not at least one eligible nominee that meets the criteria in Article IV, Section 1f.
- C. The completed slate shall be presented to the membership in Backpack Express and/or on the PTO website at least two weeks prior to the May meeting.
- D. Elections will be held at the regularly scheduled May meeting.
- E. Nominations of eligible PTO members will be accepted from the floor during the elections held at the regularly scheduled May meeting, provided individuals meet one of the qualifications listed in Article IV, Section 1f.
- F. Elections shall be by written ballot of those members present at the May meeting.
- G. In the event of a tie the Executive Board shall vote again, one vote per office, along with the first four (4) votes drawn in the written ballot, to determine the outcome.
